The deadline for chapter submissions for the **SIE CHAPTER-OF-THE-YEAR AWARD** is May 31, of the current academic year. The National Executive Board will review all submissions and determine the award by assigning quality points as outlined above. The winning chapter will be presented a professional plaque for display at its host college or university. In addition, the National Office will present a **\$500** cash grant for the chapter's use in enhancing and promoting its programs.
